<u>MUSIC NOTES</u> – Felix Mendelssohn-Bartholdy (1809-47) was an extraordinary musician in every way. When he was 12 years old he was already composing symphonic works, he was a first-rate pianist, and he was a proponent, along with Brahms, Schumann, and others, of reviving the music of Bach. Mendelssohn's organ music is modeled on the works of Bach. His *Prelude in G* is a gentle pastorale which is almost song-like in texture while the *Fugue in G* is a bold, strong, piece which shows the extent to which Bach influenced Mendelssohn's music.
