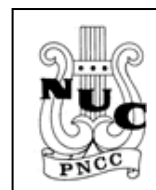

MUSIC NOTES – Dietrich Buxtehude (1637-1707) presided at two magnificent organs, one in the main nave the other in the chapel, of the Marienkirche in Lübeck. He also presided over the *Abendmusik* concerts which were famous throughout northern Europe. He was known as a very important composer and musician and the young J. S. Bach took what was supposed to be a four-week leave of absence from his church position to study with Buxtehude though the four weeks turned into four months (and one wonders how the church authorities greeted Bach upon his return!). His *Ciaconne* is a series of 30 keyboard variations over a six-note theme which is repeated throughout the piece by the pedals. His *Fugue* is based on the dance form of the jig (gigue) which was a fast dance in triple time.
