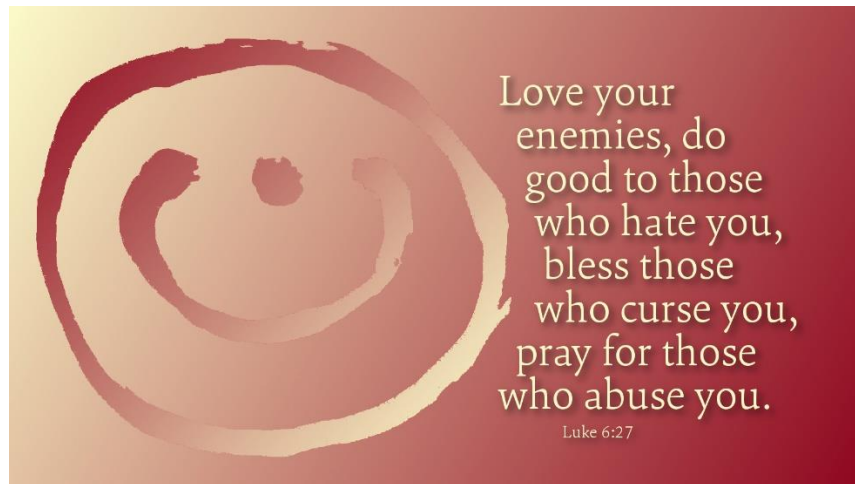

**MUSIC NOTES** – Theodore Dubois (1837-1924) was a French organist, composer, teacher, and choral director. He worked at the Paris Conservatoire and the Church of the Madeleine. His *Prélude* uses all three of the organ's keyboards to produce dialogues and echo effects throughout the piece. Eric Thiman (1900-75) was an English composer, conductor, and organist who espoused music-making by amateur musicians. His *Postlude in F* is a tuneful piece which is a spinning-out of the musical ideas which are heard at the very opening of the work.
