MUSIC NOTES – Théodore Dubois (1837-1924) was an organist, composer, and teacher. He served as choirmaster at the Church of the Madeleine and the Basilica of Sainte-Clotilde, taught composition at the Paris Conservatoire and was its director as well. His compositions include operas, ballets, symphonic works, music for the church, and organ music. His *Prélude* uses all three manuals of the organ in dialogue and echo effects while the piece's middle section makes a passing stab at a fugue. Bach's *Fantasia in C* is an early work which is reliant on rhythmic devices to propel the chordal nature of the piece forward.
