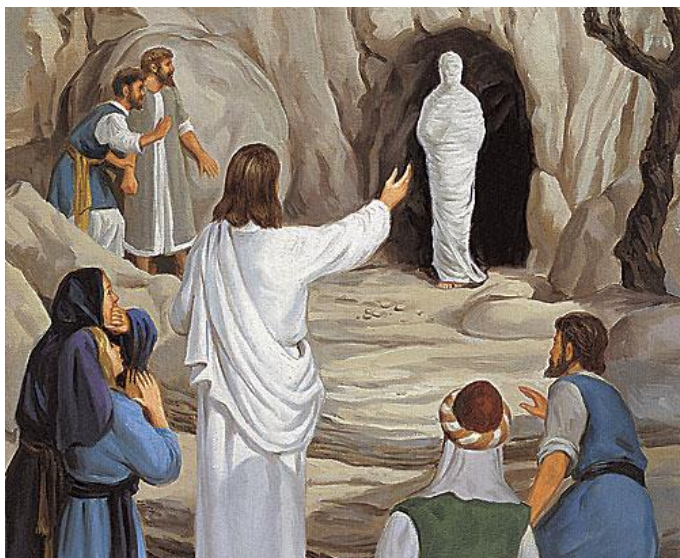

MUSIC NOTES – The hymn *O sacred head* is well known throughout Christendom as a Lenten hymn. It is sometimes called the ‘Passion chorale’ not because of its text but because Bach used this hymn several times in the course of his monumental oratorio *The Passion according to St. Matthew*. We sample two settings of it for organ this morning. In the setting by Buxtehude the hymn tune is given with florid ornamentation which still clearly preserves the outline of the melody. Brahms’ setting of the hymn *O world I now must leave thee* presents the tune forthrightly but with the extra twist of a double echo for the end of each phrase, thus the texture goes from loud, to soft, to softer throughout the course of the setting.
