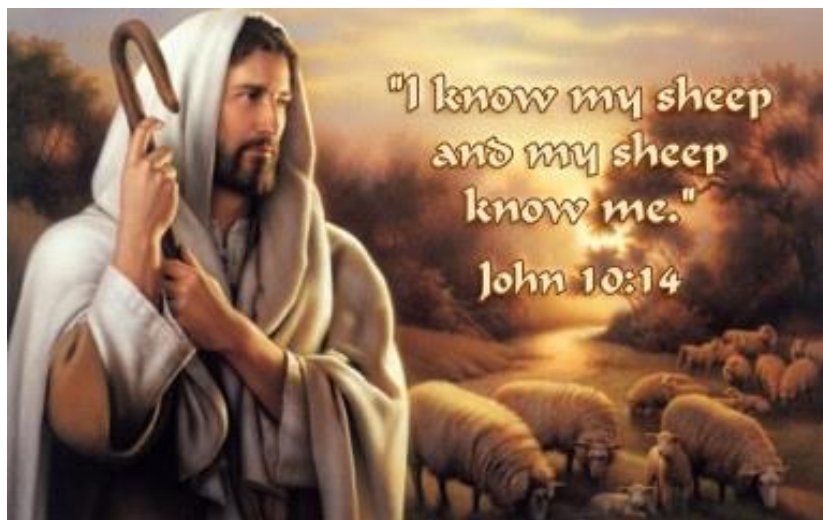

MUSIC NOTES – Louis-Nicolas Clérambault (1676-1749) was a Parisian organist and composer. He was organist at the church of Saint-Sulpice and at the royal house of Saint-Cyr, an institution for poor young women. Clérambault was a prolific composer of sacred and secular choral music and he left two sets of compositions for the organ which were meant to be played for church services. In the tradition of French organ composers his organ music is titled to indicate which organ stops to use when performing them. Thus, the *Récit de Nazard* is a melody for that specific organ stop while the *Caprice sur les grands jeux* is a piece to be played on the 'big stops' (grands jeux) of the organ.
