MUSIC NOTES – Hermann Schroeder (1904-84), the composer of today’s organ music, was professor of choral conducting and composition at the Rheinische Musikschule in Cologne in addition to being organist at the cathedral in Trier. He wrote extensively for chamber groups, choir, and organ. His compositional relied on Gregorian chant and counterpoint for its inspiration though these older forms of music were balanced with harmonies grounded in the mild dissonance of the early twentieth century. The organ works heard this morning all contain elements of ‘old school’ counterpoint, ‘modern’ harmonies, but, above all, they show an understanding of the idiomatic capabilities of the instrument.
