MUSIC NOTES – George Frideric Handel was born and educated in Germany but migrated to England early in his musical career. There he enjoyed popularity and renown known to few other musicians. His operas were popular and successful, and he was a favorite composer for the Royal Family supplying orchestral and choral music for state occasions of all types. Though Handel wrote sixteen organ concertos, he actually composed very little for organ solo, and the collection of six fugues, from which today’s organ music comes, were actually playable on the harpsichord, organ, or any other keyboard instrument. Though they are short pieces, these fugues contain all the essential elements of Handel’s musical style: lyric melody, clear counterpoint, and flowing rhythm.

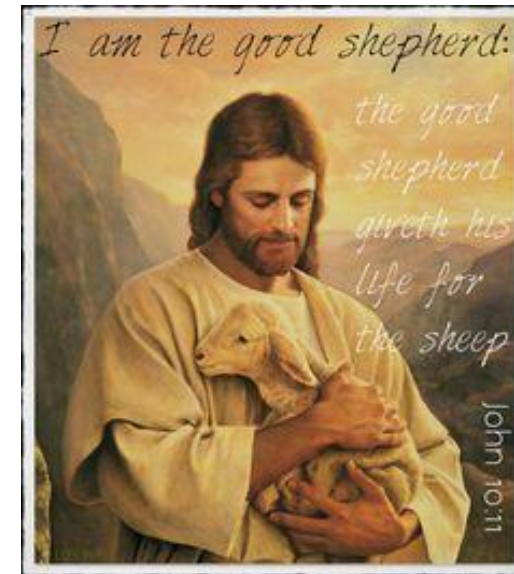
