HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY! - On behalf of the St. Stanislaus Handbell Choir, Cathedral UYA Members, and SOCL we would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge all the Mothers, Grandmothers, Aunts (God-Mothers), and all the special women in our church community that we are truly grateful for all of their love and support throughout the years. MUSIC NOTES – Today’s organ music is by two Italian composers. Bossi (1861-1925) was an organist, composer, and recitalist. He toured the USA in 1924 and played a concert at the Wannamaker store in Philadelphia. He also composed many organ works. His *Ave Maria* is a tone poem: that is, a piece which evokes, in this case, the words of the *Hail Mary*. The music suggests the sense of the prayer through it leaves the listener free to his own imaginings. Zipoli (1688-1726) was an organist, composer, and also a Jesuit monk. He was sent to Argentina in 1717 and thus ranks as one of the first composers in the Americas. His *All’offertorio* is from a set of organ pieces which were meant for specific part of the Mass: in this particular case, the piece was meant to be played at the offertory.
