MUSIC NOTES – Marco Enrico Bossi (1861-1925) was an organist, teacher, and composer. He was born in Brescia, Italy, and received his musical training in Bologna and Milan before becoming organist at Como Cathedral and professor of organ at the conservatory at Naples as well as later directorships of conservatories in Venice, Bologna, and Rome. He also toured New York and Philadelphia giving organ concerts. His *Ave Maria* is a tone poem – a piece of music which evokes another-musical event or occurrence: in this case the angel Gabriel's appearance to Mary, which forms the basis of the *Hail Mary*.
