**MUSIC NOTES** – César Franck (1822-90) was one of the most important organists and composers of his time. He was born in Belgium but studied and worked for the rest of his life in Paris where he taught at the Paris Conservatoire and was organist at the church of Ste. Clothilde. Though he was a brilliant improviser, his written compositions are grounded in the works of his predecessors though infused with the harmonies of the Romantic era. The pieces heard this morning are from a collection, *L'organiste*, which consists entirely of music to be played at various points in the Mass.

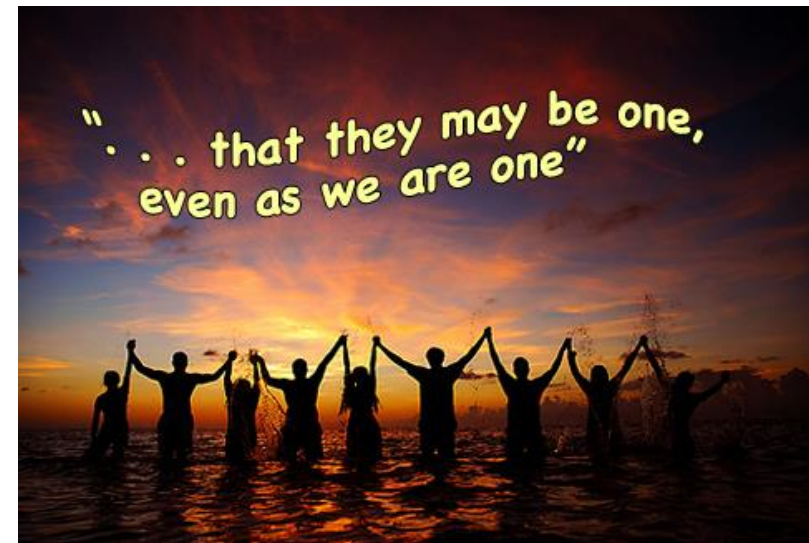
