**MUSIC NOTES** – Today's prelude and postlude come from the French tradition of organ music for church. Dupré was world-renowned as an organist, composer, and teacher. The *Antiphon V* is from a set of fifteen pieces meant to be played at Mass and at Vespers. This particular piece uses the warm and sonorous stops of the organ to emphasize its upward-moving theme and motion which seems to direct the listener's attention towards the heavens. De Grigny lived for only 31 years and was organist at the cathedral at Rheims. He left only one collection of organ pieces, but they are well-crafted enough to establish his as one of the most important organ composers of the French Baroque. The *Veni creator* is based on the Pentecost hymn *Come, creator Spirit*. The tune is played by the pedals on the trumpet stop while the hands accompany it on the "plein jeu," or the "full stops."
