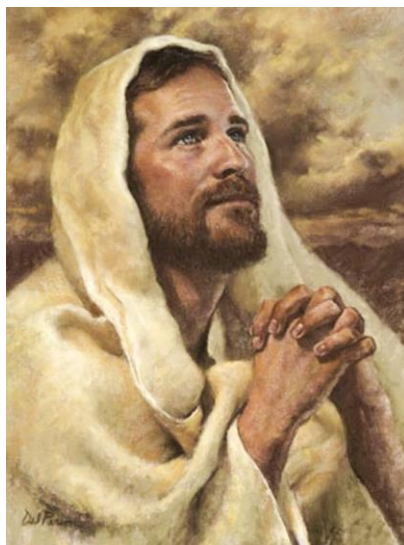

**MUSIC NOTES** – David N. Johnson (1922-88) was an American organist, teacher, church musician, and composer. He taught at Syracuse University, St. Olaf College, and the University of Arizona. He wrote over three hundred works, mostly for church use. He is best remembered for his many trumpet tunes for the organ and for the choral composition, *The lone wild bird*, which is sung for the offertory. Johnson, when he was in the US Armed Services, spied a single white bird in the middle of the Pacific while he was on a ship en route from the USA to India. The image of that bird haunted him because of its distance from any land and it apparently brought to mind the text by McFayden which Johnson later paired with an American folk tune to create a work reminding us of our being always in the sight of God.
