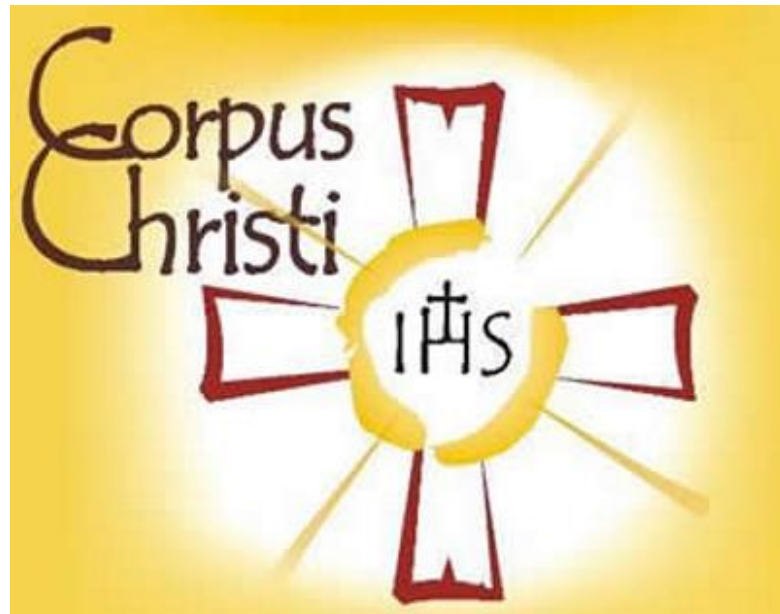

PARISH COMTTEE INFORMATION – Arrangements are in place to repair the rectory roof beginning the last week in June. Parish committee members met with Ed Deiner, roofing contractor, and will review plans for work on the Cathedral steeple. An anonymous donor has provided funds for lighting the mosaic on the front of the Cathedral. Plans are being researched for improvements in the church hall, including proper display of photographs. The consensus is the mask of Bishop Hodur, currently in a glass case, should be moved to the Chancery. The profit from the 300 Club Raffle was \$2,980.00 with 284 tickets sold. 251 parishioners have returned pledges or 43% of our membership.
