MUSIC NOTES – The Pentecost hymn *Veni creator (Come, Holy Spirit)* is believed to have been written in the 9th century. It was not only used for Pentecost but at other solemn occasions in the church. Its popularity and importance is indicated by its continued use from the 9th century to the present day, and its publication in no less than 99 current hymnals. In fact, today's opening hymn (144) is derived from both the original text and Gregorian chant melody. The Gregorian chant has been used throughout history by composers such as Mahler, Berlioz, Bruckner, Hindemith and many organ composers. The prelude is Bach's setting of the tune (with a text by Martin Luther published in 1524). Bach alludes to the wind and fire of that first Pentecost by a flickering rhythmic figure accompanying the first statement of the hymn tune and by flowing scale in the second statement of the tune (which is in the pedal part). Nicolas de Grigny treats the tune on a solo stop, again in the pedals, while the keyboard part constructs a grand march on the *plein jeu* or 'full stops' of the organ.
