MUSIC NOTES – Domenico Zipoli, the composer of today's prelude and postlude, led an interesting life which touched the world of music, theology, and international travel. He was born in Italy in 1688 and received his musical training in Prato, Florence, and Bologna with some of the most illustrious musicians of the time. In 1716 he travelled to Spain to join the Jesuit order and he completed his studies in Buenos Aires in 1724 where he served as musician at the Jesuit church there. He died in 1726. He composed music for choir, singers, organ, and keyboard, and is one of the earliest musicians and composers of the New World. The titles of the pieces heard today indicate their function: *All' Elevazione* was meant to be played at the elevation of the bread and wine, while *All' Offertorio* was meant for the offertory.
