MUSIC NOTES – A chorale prelude is a composition which is based on a hymn tune or other sacred melody. Though Buxtehude (1637-1707) is credited with establishing the genre, examples exist prior to his lifetime. The main purpose of a chorale prelude is either (this point is still debated today) to introduce a hymn for the congregation to sing, or was part of the pre-service music to indicate one of the hymns to be sung in the service. Today's prelude is an example. Johann Gottfried Walther (1684-1748) wrote the prelude which we hear today based on the tune of *Praise to the Lord* which is our opening hymn. The tune is plainly heard, one phrase at a time, in the pedals (the lowest voice) while over it the manuals weave music which is composed of fragments of the hymn tune.
