MUSIC NOTES – **MUSIC NOTES:** Louis Vierne (1870-1937) was organist at Notre-Dame Cathedral in Paris from 1900 until his death. He was a prodigious composer, famous recitalist, and a revered teacher. His compositions incorporate colorful and suggestive harmonies and many of his organ works are descriptive in nature, such as today's *Lied*, which is an evocation of an art-song. The principal melody is heard in the tenor register though it also permeates the rest of the texture before returning in its original form. Craig Sellar Lang (1891-1971), the composer of today's postlude, was born in New Zealand but emigrated to Great Britain where he continued his education and spent the rest of his life. His *Tuba tune* is a sprightly piece for the organ's powerful solo stop and is written in the style of the eighteenth-century organ voluntaries which featured one of the organ's solo stops.

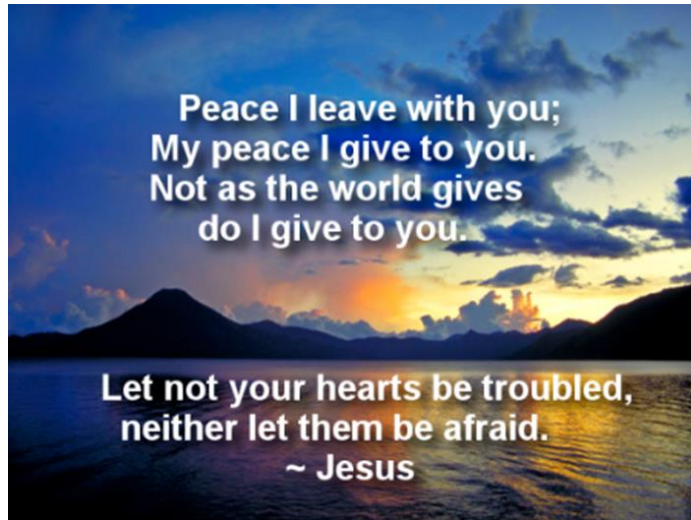

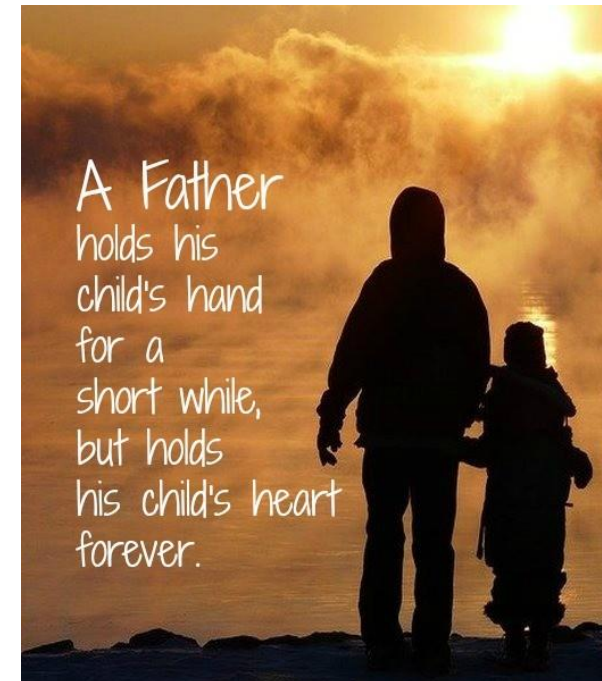
