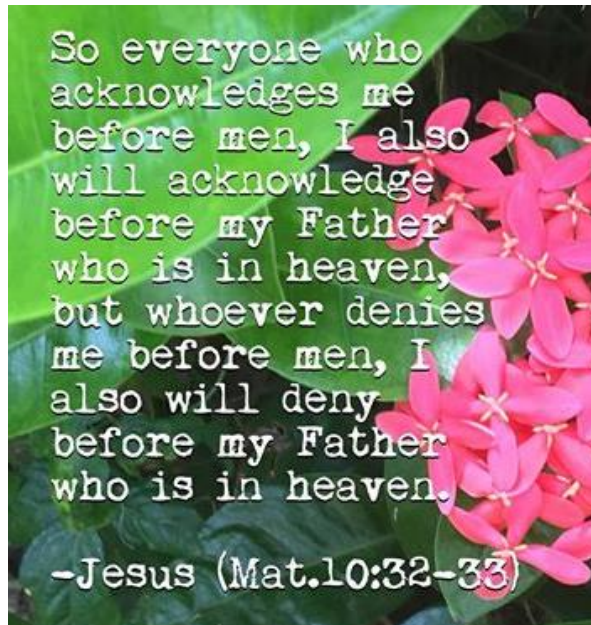

MUSIC NOTES – A passacaglia (pronounced pass-a-cal-ee-ah) originated in Spain in the early 1600s as a strummed (on stringed instruments) interlude between dances or songs. It migrated to the keyboard and assumed a musical form refined by Italian musicians of the 1620s. Its classic form is as a series of variations played over a repeating bass pattern. In Buxtehude's *Passacaglia* there are 28 variations which the keyboard weaves over a seven-note pattern in long notes which is continually repeated by the pedals. Because the passacaglia presents intellectual and musical challenges (i.e. concocting variations, keeping them interesting, etc.) it is a form which has been used by composers throughout history even to the present day and it has broadened its playing mediums from being a keyboard piece to include all instruments and the orchestra.
