MUSIC NOTES – The hymn *I vow to thee, my country* has become an all-pervasive anthem for state holidays describing how the Christian owes loyalty to his/her own country as well as to God. The first stanza deals with the earthly country; the second stanza deals with the Godly ‘country.’ The text was first written in about 1912 by Cecil Spring Rice, who was a British diplomat posted to the USA from 1912 to 1918. In about 1921 a British music publisher approached the composer Gustav Holst to set the poem to music. Holst found that a tune he had used in his large orchestral piece *The Planets* seemed to fit the cadence of the poem, thus it was that the tune from the movement *Jupiter* gained new life as the melody by which *I vow to thee my country* would be forever after known. The piece was first published in a hymnal in 1925 and has since been published not only as a hymn or patriotic song but also in arrangements such as the organ arrangement which is today’s prelude.
