**MUSIC NOTES** – Gustav Holst (1874-1934) was a composer and a music educator who pioneered music education for women during his years at St. Paul’s Girls School in London. His most famous work is an orchestral suite, *The Planets*, from which the tune for today’s anthem is taken. The text for this piece comes from a poem by the British diplomat Sir Cecil Spring Rice. The poem’s first stanza refers to love for one’s country while the subsequent stanza names ‘another country’ referring to heaven. The text is:

I vow to thee, my country, all earthly things above,  
Entire and whole and perfect, the service of my love;  
The love that asks no question, the love that stands the test,  
That lays upon the altar the dearest and the best;  
The love that never falters, the love that pays the price,  
The love that makes undaunted the final sacrifice.

And there's another country, I've heard of long ago,  
Most dear to them that love her, most great to them that know;  
We may not count her armies, we may not see her King;  
Her fortress is a faithful heart, her pride is suffering;  
And soul by soul and silently her shining bounds increase,  
And her ways are ways of gentleness, and all her paths are peace.
