**MUSIC NOTES** – A ‘voluntary’ denotes a piece of music, usually for the organ, which is played before or after a service. The term is English in origin and began to be used in the late Renaissance and it is still used today. The *Organ voluntary* by Manuel Emilio is lyric and somewhat free in style not unlike much of the piano music of the same time. Emilio (1812-71) was born in Spain and immigrated to the USA sometime before 1944 settling in Salem, MA. He served as a church organist and was a composer of organ and solo vocal music.
