MUSIC NOTES – The hymn *Praise to the Lord* has been sung by Christians since its publication in 1680. The tune and text have been used for many large-scale choral settings as well as many hymn-prelude settings. The organ setting we hear this morning is by J. G. Walther who, in addition to being a composer and music scholar in his own right, was a cousin of J. S. Bach. Walther has set the hymn tune for the pedal division (the lowest voices) of the organ though throughout the piece the manual (keyboard) parts use snippets of the tune to ‘hint’ at each upcoming phrase of the tune. Though it is a relatively short work, it shows Walther’s superior craftsmanship and genius. Mark Jones, the composer of the postlude, is currently Director of Music and Organist at a Presbyterian church in Boca Raton, Florida. The *Trumpet tune* was composed as a wedding gift for friends of Mr. Jones and combines an old musical form with new musical language.

PARISH COMMITTEE UPDATE – The following is a brief summary of action items from the June 21st meeting:

1. 261 members have returned their Pledge System Forms or 45% of our membership.
2. 256 Pledge Form reminder letters were sent on June 20th, to those who have not responded with a pledge.
3. All parish members who submitted a pledge form were sent a progress update.
4. A large laminated wall calendar has been placed in the church hall. Pens for updating this calendar will be kept in the Parish Office.
5. Because of a tragic, fatal, work accident to our roofing contractor, Charles Diirner, we are in the process of developing a work timeline with his brother. He is now heading up the company and communicating with us to attempt to proceed with the rectory roof and church steeple projects. This unfortunate accident has set the project back, which was originally scheduled to begin the end of June.
6. Cemetery prices were reviewed and presented at a Parish meeting held on June 26th. Prices were approved at that meeting.
7. A proposal to rent our corner property on Pittston Avenue and East Elm Street to a food truck vendor, whose daughter attends our elementary school, was discussed. It was agreed to further pursue this opportunity as long as it doesn't interfere with any other church events. It would give our property additional exposure and visibility. The rental fee income will go directly to the elementary school operational budget, per the vendor's request.
