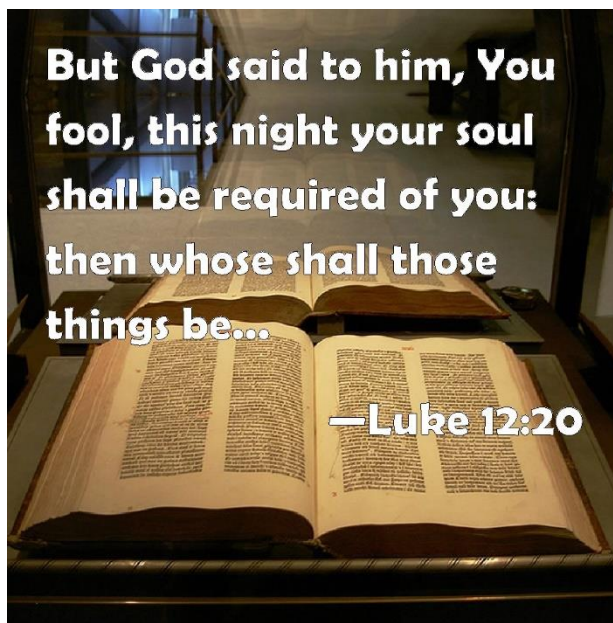

MUSIC NOTES – Felix Mendelssohn (1809-47) accomplished an amazing number of things in his very short life. He composed music for every genre, from orchestra to solo voice, and was an accomplished performer and conductor. Though he was born into a prominent Jewish family, when he was seven he was baptized, as were his parents, into the Reformed Church. His prodigious musical talents were also recognized at about the same time and by nine years of age Mendelssohn was performing as a pianist and already dabbling in composition. Among his interests was the music of J. S. Bach, and he joined with Brahms, Schumann, and other prominent composers of the time to revive Bach's music. The organ music heard this morning is from a set of six organ sonatas which were commissioned by a British publisher as the result of a concert tour of Great Britain where Mendelssohn performed several organ recitals. The offertory solo is from his large oratorio, which was inspired by Handel's *Messiah*, called *Elijah*.
