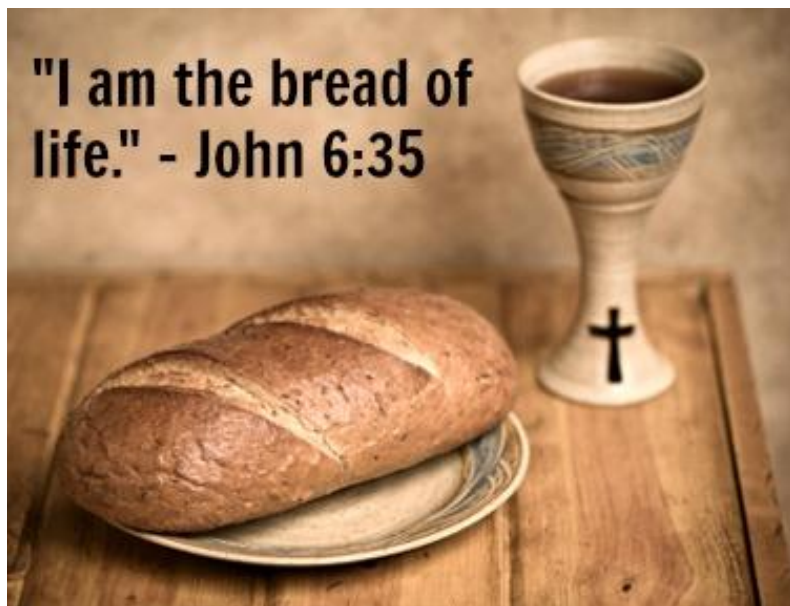

MUSIC NOTES – Manuel Emilio (1812-71) was born in Spain but emigrated to, and lived in, Salem, MA where he became organist at one of the Catholic churches. He published a few songs, but much of his organ music remains in unpublished manuscript. His organ voluntary shows signs of his lyricism as well as his grounding in the keyboard style of the nineteenth century. Handel (1685-1759) wrote sixteen organ concertos, six fugues for organ or harpsichord and no other organ music. The *Fugue in D* shows Handel's reliance on melody, rather than on counterpoint, to propel the piece forward.
