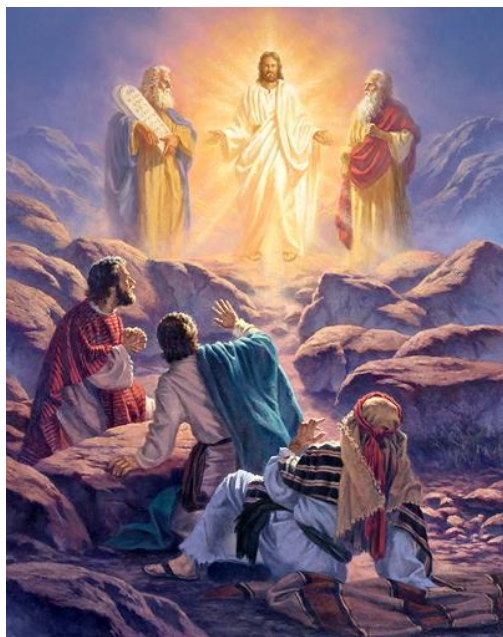

**MUSIC NOTES** – Today's prelude and postcommunion solo are linked. The solo, *Humbly I adore Thee*, is a Plainsong (which is another name for 'chant') setting of a hymn text written in the 13<sup>th</sup> century by Thomas Aquinas, who was a Benedictine monk. The hymn has been used throughout the history of church music and is still in use today. Everett Titcomb (1884-1968) was a Boston-based organist and composer who composed mostly choral and organ music. His setting *Adoro te devote* is a meditative piece which is based on Thomas Aquinas's hymn: the melody is presented in its entirety about half-way through the piece. His *Andante marziale (march-like andante)* is at once lyrical and festive in nature.
