**MUSIC NOTES** – Vincent Lübeck was contemporary with Bach. He was well known during his lifetime as a composer and organist and he worked at Hamburg's Church of St. Nikolai where he presided at one of the largest organs of his time. Unfortunately few of his works survive only two cantatas and a handful of organ works. His *Prelude and Fugue in F* is a cheerful piece which, while being solidly constructed, makes use of virtuosic elements such as a busy part for the pedals to play. Heinrich Scheidemann lived almost a hundred years before Lübeck though he also worked in the same city at the church of St. Catherine. He received his training from his father, also an organist, and with the renowned Dutch organist Sweelinck. In Scheidemann's *Praeambulum* one hears the musical language of the late Renaissance transitioning to the early Baroque which he uses to great advantage in showing off different textures and sonorities.
