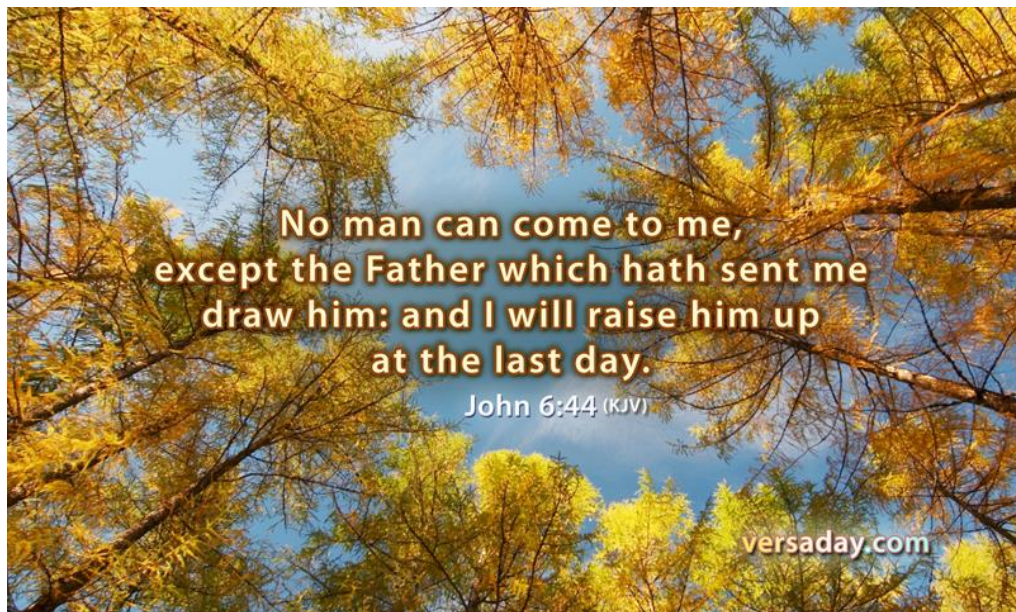

MUSIC NOTES – Samuel Wesley (1766-1837) was the nephew of the founder of the Methodist church, John Wesley, and the son of the famous hymn-writer Charles Wesley. In his own right he was known as a violinist, organist, and composer and is sometimes referred to as the ‘English Mozart’ since he lived at the same time as Mozart. His *Air* is typical of ‘tunes’ set for the organ: a lyric melody and its repetition allows the organist to display several of the different solo sounds of the organ. The *Gavotte* is a dance of French folk origin in duple meter. Wesley’s composition is joyous and straightforward in nature.
