**MUSIC NOTES** – Hermann Schroeder (1904-84), the composer of today's prelude and postlude, was a German composer, church musician, and pedagogue. His work as an organist, conductor, and composer continued his work as a teacher of choral conducting, counterpoint, and composition at the Rheinische Musikschule in Cologne. His composition style represented a break with the musical style of the nineteenth century (the 'romantic' tradition): he used chant-like melodies, and a more austere rather than sensual harmonic language. The *Andante* is an example of his use of melody which through imitation (the repetition of the same melody in different places) creates its own texture. The *Poco vivace* uses big block chords, non-symmetrical rhythms, and cascades of sound to produce a brilliant effect.

**PRESBYTERAL ORDINATION** – Deacon Donald Wunderlich of Easton, PA will be ordained a Polish National Catholic Church priest on **Saturday, August 27, 2016 at Saint Stanislaus Bishop and Martyr Cathedral, Scranton**. The ordination Mass will be held at 10 am with the Right Reverend Bernard Nowicki, DD, Bishop Ordinary of the Central Diocese, PNCC officiating. Diocesan and Cathedral choir members, Diocesan as well as Cathedral ANS members, area clergy and Cathedral parishioners are invited to participate in and witness this grace-filled event in the life of our Diocese. His first Mass as a priest will be celebrated as Father Donald Wunderlich at Our Saviour PNC Parish in Lawrenceville, New Jersey at 3 pm on Sunday, August 28, 2016.

**CONCERT: SAVE THE DATE** – On **Tuesday, September 13, at 7:00 PM** St. Stanislaus' will host a concert by the Serbian-born accordion (yes, accordion!) virtuoso Petar Marić presented by the World Artists Experiences, Washington, DC and the cooperative efforts of the First Catholic Slovak Ladies Association, the Slovak Heritage Society of Northeastern Pennsylvania, Wilkes University Polish Room, Polish Union USA/Ameripol, among other organizations. Apart from classical music originally written for accordion or transcriptions for compositions written for other instruments, Petar also plays a large number of virtuoso-compositions from the varié genre consisting of music from different countries and of different styles, enabling this world-class young artist to show the audience all the attraction and possibilities of accordion as an instrument.

Born in Belgrade, Serbia in 1990, Petar Maric was introduced to the accordion at the age of five. He is the winner of numerous musical and cultural awards including four world champion titles in international accordion competitions. Mr. Maric specializes in classical music as well as eclectic variety compositions and is a pioneer in the performance of electronic accordion music. Mr. Maric's extraordinary talent, musicality and domination on stage have made him heard and remembered throughout Europe, the orient and Pacific Rim nations.
