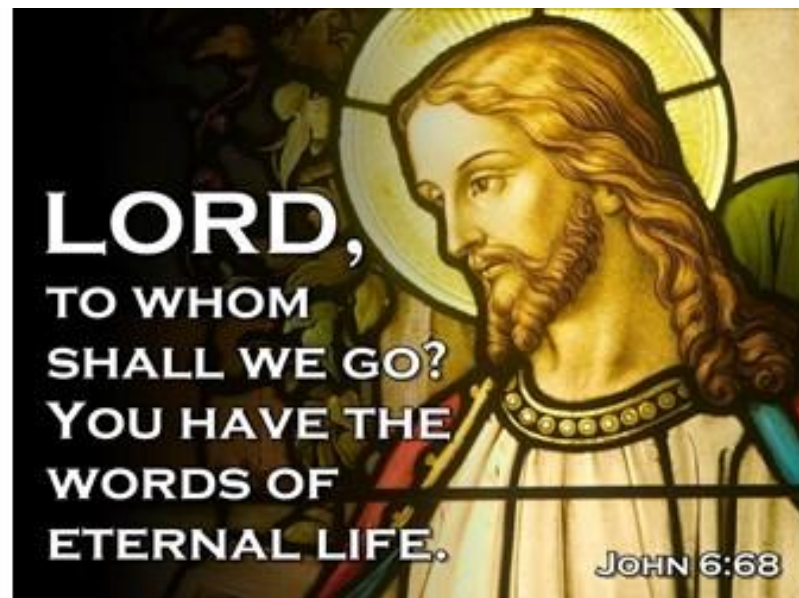

**MUSIC NOTES** – Girolamo Frescobaldi (1583-1643) was a child prodigy from Ferrara who made his way to Rome when he was in his early 20s. He held various positions at different churches and courts both as keyboard player and composer. He served as organist at the Vatican from 1608-28 and 1634-43. His organ compositions are contained in a collection called *Fiori musicali* (*Musical flowers*) and are pieces expressly composed for use at Mass. Thus, today's prelude and postlude are titled: *Canzon*

*dopo l'Epistola* (*song for after the epistle*) and *Canzon post il Comune* (*song for after communion*). The title 'canzona' was used at that time to differentiate a piece in a lighter style from the improvisatory toccata or the stricter, more learned, *ricercare*.
