MUSIC NOTES – Today's organ music is by American composers. Paul Hindemith (1895-1963) was a German violist, violinist, and composer whose training and early career was spent in his native land. In the 1930s his music became controversial in the eyes of the then German government and ultimately he emigrated to the USA in 1940, teaching composition at Yale University. His musical style is of the 20th century but is gentle in his use of new harmonies. He relied on historical musical models for his compositions as exemplified by the *Adagio* from his second organ sonata. It is in what is often called 'song form' where melodies are repeated. David N. Johnson (1922-87) taught at St. Olaf College and Syracuse University before moving to Arizona where he taught at AZ State University. His trumpet tune (which is one of many pieces he composed in this form) harks back to the many trumpet voluntaries of 18th century England though it is imbued with a distinctly 20th-century American sound.

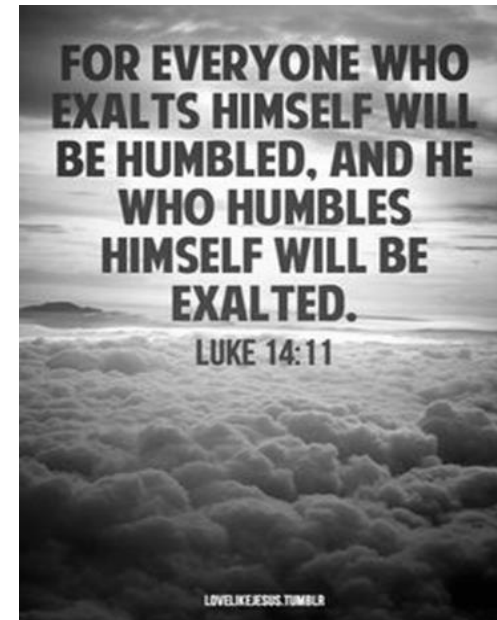
