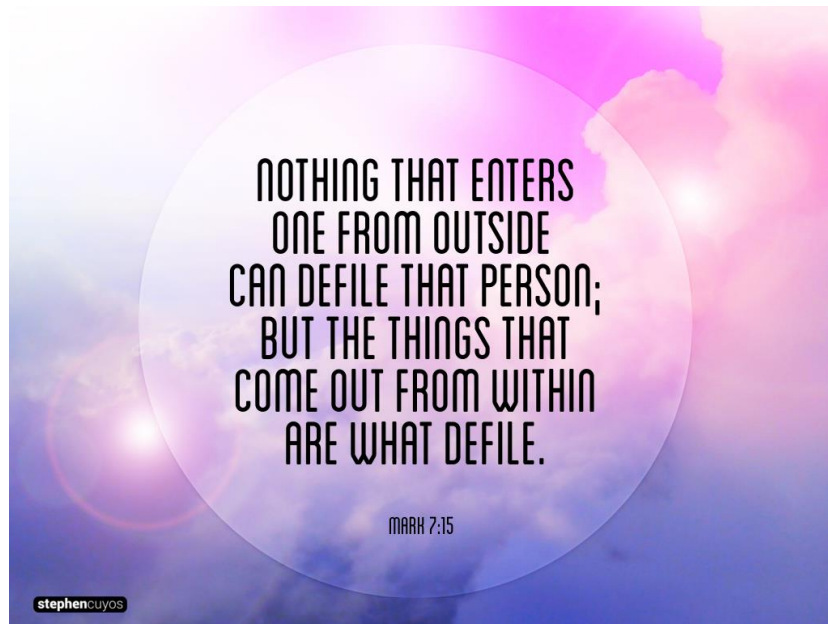

MUSIC NOTES – César Franck (1822-90) was born in Belgium but studied and worked in Paris where he was professor of organ and composition at the Paris Conservatoire and organist at the church of Ste. Clothilde. In addition to his work as a teacher, he was known as a performer and was especially noted as a skilled improviser, which was (and still is) a specialty of French organists. Though he wrote chamber music, oratorios, and a symphony, he is best known for his sacred and organ music. His musical style combines traditional forms with ‘new’ harmonies which infuse his compositions with a heightened sense of expression. His melodic gift is apparent in his setting of *O Lord most holy* while his *Offertoire* and *Sortie* succeed in showing some of the colors of the organ of Franck’s time.
