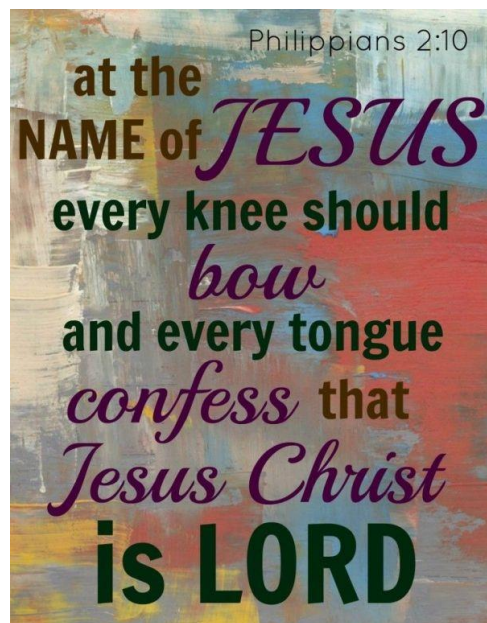

**MUSIC NOTES** – François Couperin (1668-1733) is often referred to as ‘le grand (the great)’ to differentiate him from other members of his distinguished musical family who were also named François. Both François’s father and his brother held the position of organist at the church of St. Gervais in Paris (indeed, members of this family held this position from 1653-1826) and when Couperin’s father died at an early age (and when François was 11) the church stipulated that François would become organist there when he was 18. He also served at the Royal Court of France as composer, harpsichordist, and organist. His organ compositions consist of two ‘organ masses,’ which were collections of pieces to be played at specific points of the Mass. Thus the *Elevation* was to be played at the consecration while the *Fugue* is indicated to be played at the Kyrie (Lord have mercy). In typical fashion of the time, French organists indicated the stops to be used in the title of their pieces, thus the *tierce en taille* indicates a specific combination of sounds to be used as a solo by the left hand, while the *fugue sur les jeux d’anches* means, literally, *fugue for the reed (i.e. trumpet) stops*.
