**MUSIC NOTES** – William Boyce (1711-79) was an English composer and organists. He began his musical life as a boy chorister at St. Paul's, London, and went on to be Master of the King's Music and organist at the Chapel Royal. Among his compositions for choir and orchestra is a collection of ten organ voluntaries. The word 'voluntary' refers to an organ solo played before, during, or after a church service. Many organ voluntaries consist of a slow introductory section which is followed by the musical 'meat' of the voluntary. Such is the case with both voluntaries heard this morning. *Voluntary I* is designated for the trumpet stop which is heard as a solo stop and is used in dialogue with other, contrasting, stops. *Voluntary VIII* begins with an introduction on full organ before launching into a fugue.
