MUSIC NOTES – Today's prelude and postlude, illustrate two of the many different costumes that a *fantasia* can don. In the case of Sweelinck (1562-1621) the piece takes the form of a dialogue contrasting the sounds of two of the organ's keyboards – hence the 'echo' nature of the work as indicated by its title. Pachelbel (1653-1706) chooses a different form for his fantasia: he is more concerned with the movement of harmony from one chord to another and the sonority that is produced though he also uses small recurring rhythmic motives to propel the piece forward.
