MUSIC NOTES – Both George Oldroyd and Eric Thiman were British composers who, in addition to holding church positions themselves, contributed to the organ and choral repertoire of the 20th century. Both men taught in London and wrote on music. Oldroyd is noted for his musical style which combines lush harmonies with inspiration of music of earlier times recalling the ‘palm court’ style of music popular in the early 20th century. Thiman was a proponent of amateur music-making and his musical style strove to be both musically and technically accessible as well as artistic.
