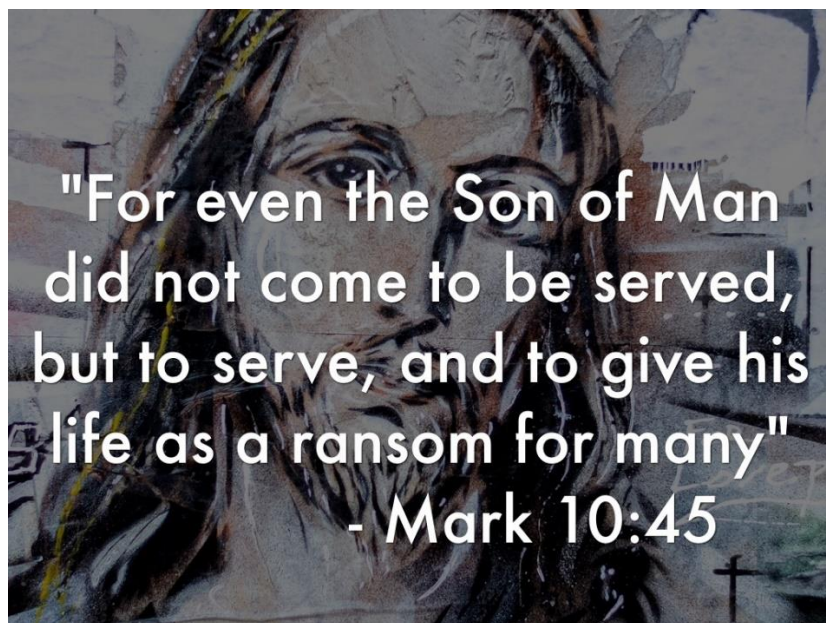

MUSIC NOTES – Johann Pachelbel (1653-1706) was a German organist and teacher. He had many pupils and was a long-standing friend of the Bach family and was recognized as a composer in his own right. His partita (a set of nine variations) on the hymn tune *Was Gott tut, das ist wohlgetan* (What God ordains is always good) is the same hymn tune which is sung as the offertory anthem. Pachelbel's imagination is readily apparent in the many moods and types of variations he works on the hymn tune.
