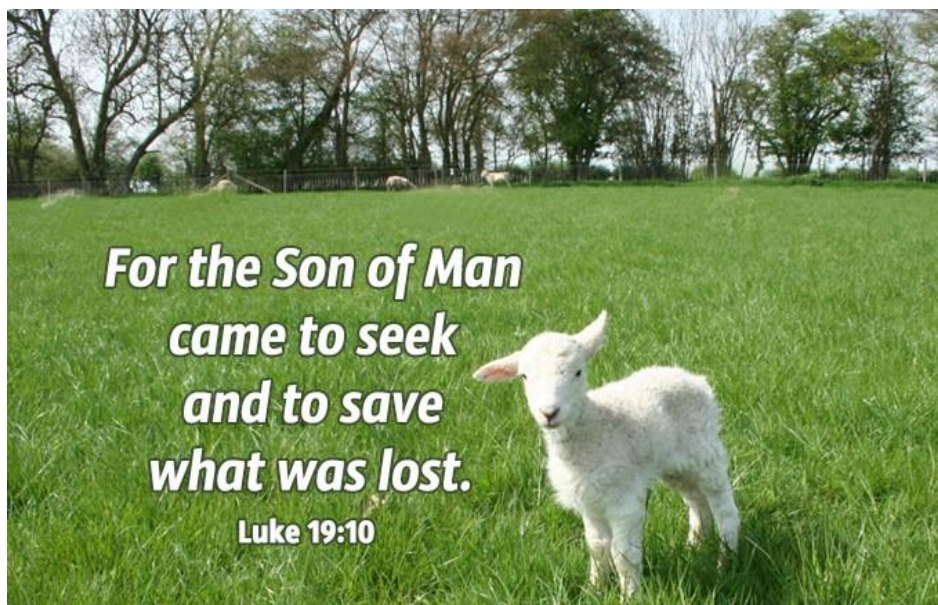

MUSIC NOTES – Daniel Lesur (1908-2002) was a Parisian organist and composer whose mother was also a composer in her own right. He was a colleague and friend of many important French musicians and was a co-founder of La Jeune France which was an association dedicated to a more ‘human’ and less abstract form of musical composition. His short, quiet piece *In paradisum* is an example of that goal. It relied on that part of the funeral Mass which begins with the words, “May the angels lead you into paradise” and presents the chant associated with those words in an ethereal fashion with only a slight divergence into a section which seems to portray a sense of grief. Edward G. Mead (1892-1987) was an American organist and composer who lived and worked in Ohio. His *Fantasy on ‘Sine Nomine’* presents Vaughan-William’s famous and popular hymn tune in a clear distinct after a series of musical allusions to the opening phrase of the tune.
