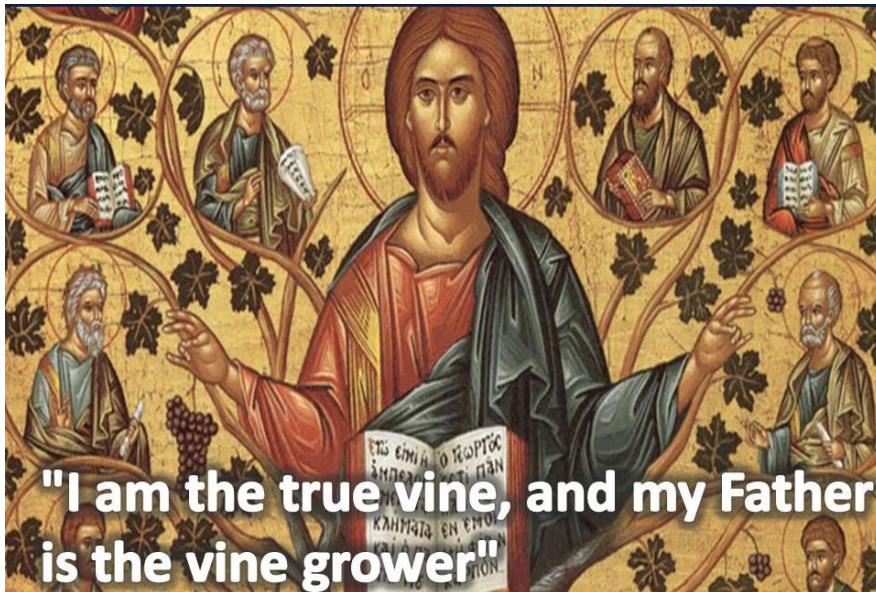

**MUSIC NOTES** – Louis Vierne's *Andantino* is made up of two large elements. The first is a quiet melodic passage which is supported by hauntingly beautiful harmonies. The second element is a more lively, though short figure which begins high but repeats at successively lower pitches and which leads back to a restatement of the first quiet melodic passage. These two elements alternate twice before the first element returns to end the work. It is curious that while the piece is titled 'andantino' meaning 'a bit lively,' Vierne marks the performance tempo as 'adagio' meaning 'comfortable' with the connotation 'on the slow side.' This ambiguity is, perhaps, explained by Vierne in the preface to the piece which indicates that the tempo should be subject to the size of the church and the characteristic of the organ's quickness of response.
