**MUSIC NOTES** – Flor Peeters (1903-86) was a Belgian organist, composer, and teacher. He began music studies at the Lemmens Institute when he was sixteen and when he was 20 he became organist at the cathedral of St. Rumbold in Mchelen where he remained for the rest of his life. He was an important composer of Catholic choral and organ music. His *Aria* presents a tranquil, simple melody in the style of a song. Johann Gottfried Walther (1684-1748) was a cousin and contemporary of J. S. Bach. Among his many achievements was his compilation and publication of the first German dictionary of musical terms and musicians. Among his many organ compositions is the setting of the hymn *Praise to the Lord* in which the hymn tune is distinctly heard in the lowest voice of the texture.
