**National United Choirs Music Scholarship History**

The Music Scholarship Program was instituted on August 8, 1964 by the Sixth General Convention of the National United Choirs of the Polish National Catholic Church held in Carnegie, PA. The program was implemented at the Seventh General Convention held in Cleveland, OH, on August 4, 1966, when the first awards were presented. The Music Scholarship Program was instituted and tailored to develop musicians within the Polish National Catholic Church. The program was further expanded to establish a chair of music at Savonarola Theological Seminary in Scranton, PA, and to make scholarships available in other areas of music to enrich the musical life of the church.

With the 2022 Scholarships awarded, we have given out 1124 scholarships totaling \$346,535. Please see the list of this year's awardees on the "2022 Winners" page.

The window for applying for the 2023 Scholarships will open January 1, 2023 and will continue until May 1, 2023.

Winners will be announced at the NUC Music Workshop held on August 10 & 11, 2023 at Holy Mother of Sorrows Parish in Dupont, PA.
