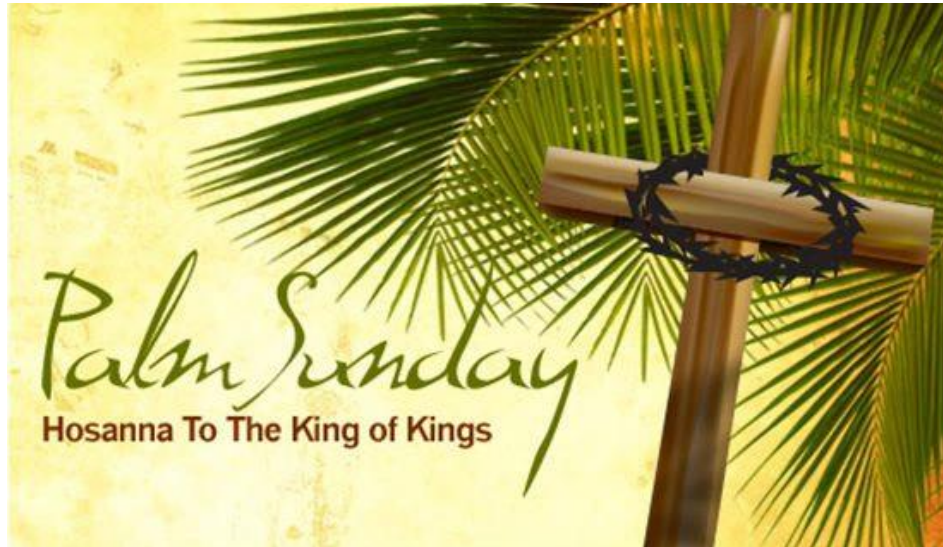

****Mass of Easter Sunday** – Please note carefully the change in the scheduled hour of the second Mass at **10:30 am** on Easter Sunday.

Please Note – On Easter Sunday we will begin receiving Holy Communion once again at the altar rail. However, we can only use the altar rail cloth when our acolytes will be with us once again in order to position and remove that cloth for us.

Our Mass of Chrism this Tuesday, April 4th at 4:00 pm, gathers the diocese around the bishop before the beginning of the Triduum, so that priests may take home the holy oils and sacred chrism needed for various sacraments throughout the coming year.

The Liturgy of this Mass celebrates the dignity of all who have been made Christ's disciples through baptism and anointing. Gathering in the unity of the people with their priests around their bishop for the consecration of the chrism, everyone is reminded that no one ever responds to this call alone or on one's own.

The Chrism Mass also gives attention to the ordained figures of the Diocese who renew their priestly promises within the liturgy. The ordained priesthood serves all who have been baptized in order that they would be strengthened, sanctified and instructed. They, in turn, by virtue of their baptisms, will strengthen, sanctify, and teach the world in which they live, in their families, schools, workplaces, sporting and leisure activities, politics, community involvement and beyond.

The Chrism Mass reminds us of our oneness in Christ through baptism and its holy anointings, which are only made possible by the ministry of the bishop and his priests.

Please plan to attend in order to experience this beautiful Mass.
