Sound of Freedom, an Important Movie (now screening locally) – “Sound of Freedom” sheds light on the rapidly expanding business of child sexual trafficking in the United States. It focuses on the true story of a special agent who quits his job to save children from trafficking.

“Sound of Freedom” was shot in 2018 in Cartagena, Colombia. It was produced by 20th Century Fox. When Disney acquired the studio in 2019, Disney decided to shelve the film. Angel Studios, headquartered in Provo, Utah, picked up the movie after negotiations and garnering enough funds.

Caviezel, in a special on-screen message upon the film’s conclusion, said he believes that Sound of Freedom can be the “Uncle Tom’s Cabin’ of 21st-century slavery.”

He noted that the film, although shot five years ago, “wasn’t released til now, with every roadblock that you can imagine being tossed in the way.”

Neal Harmon, CEO of Angel Studios, (makers of “The Chosen”) said in a statement: “Thanks to fans around the country, Sound of Freedom earned the top spot as America’s number one movie on Independence Day. We’ve received numerous messages telling us theaters are either packed or sold out. This movie has now taken on a life of its own to become something more than that, a grassroots movement.
