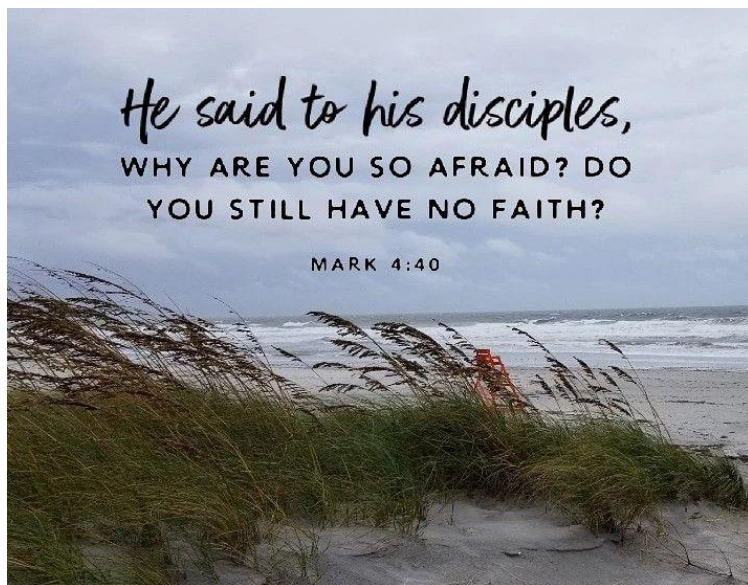

Donations vs Expenses at St. Stanislaus Cathedral – March 2024

Sunday Envelopes - \$16,881.00 (5 weeks, including Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday)

All additional income - \$37,962.88 (tenant rents, hall rentals, member income received at the office, yearly endowment disbursement, miscellaneous funds).

Expenses: \$54,522.51 – Expenses include (but are not limited to) salaries, utilities, and costs incurred to operate the Cathedral and its properties.

95th Anniversary of Spójnia Farm & Blessing of the Great Hall Renovations – On **July 4, 2024**, we honor the 95th anniversary of the blessing and dedication of the Spójnia Farm property by Bishop Francis Hodur on July 4, 1929. Holy Mass will be celebrated by Prime Bishop Mikovsky at 11:00 a.m. followed by the blessing and dedication of the major renovation of the Great Hall/Pavilion.
