

We will be making 12” Italian or turkey hoagies, as well as take and bake plain and pepperoni square pizzas. For the first time, there will also be limited number of 1-quart containers of Haluszki, homemade by our very own number Father Janusz! Pick up will be Saturday, **in the Youth Center**, from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM

The price for the hoagies will be \$10.00 each, which includes lettuce, tomato and onion, as well as condiments (oil/vinegar, mayo or spicy mustard), all prepackaged on the side. Pizzas will be 12-cut square and are \$17.00 for plain and \$20.00 for pepperoni. **Haluszki will be \$10.00/quart, available in limited quantities, and first come, first served.**
