

#### NUC Music Scholarship: History

The Music Scholarship Program was instituted on August 8, 1964 by the Sixth General Convention of the National United Choirs of the Polish National Catholic Church held in Carnegie, PA. The program was implemented at the Seventh General Convention held in Cleveland, OH, on August 4, 1966, when the first awards were presented. The Music Scholarship Program was instituted and tailored to develop musicians within the Polish National Catholic Church. The program was further expanded to establish a chair of music at Savonarola Theological Seminary in Scranton, PA, and to make scholarships available in other areas of music to enrich the musical life of the church.

The Music Scholarship Program has a number of endowments and awards that are available to members of the PNCC, whether it is via instrument or voice, regardless of age. The NUC website, <u>www.nucmusicscholarship.weebly.com</u> is designed for one to learn about the program – its history, awards and latest winners. Downloads for the the 2025 application process are also available on this site.

With the 2024 Scholarships awarded, we have given out 1145 scholarships totaling \$358,085.

# The window for applying for the 2025 Scholarships is current and will continue until May 1, 2025.

<u>Seminary and Seminarians</u> (*from Fr Jim Konicki, National Vocations Director*) – We have been praying regularly for the gift of vocations and God is answering our pleas. We have six men in formation for the priesthood and several on track for entry into the Savonarola Theological Seminary. Others regularly seek vocations information.

As you may be aware, the seminary building was in significant need of updating and repair. Pipes were leaking, the restrooms and showers were unstable, the furnace / boiler dating to the mid-50's is shot, old cast iron cast pipes needed replacement.

We have undertaken the projects in a phased approach. The YMSR Central Committee put together a team to clean out the seminary. Thank you to Nick K., Nick C., Kevin, Jeremy and the Stankowski men for your hard work.

In the weeks and months ahead, the library will be re-catalogued, the plumbing fixed, the bathroom and shower redone, and the boiler replaced. Other YMSR branches and parishes have reached out to help through fundraisers and financial donations, as well as in-kind work.

We foresee parishes and dioceses who will benefit from having these men in ministry also stepping up to help.
