Lectors: 6/22 – 8:00 – Kathy Michalina 9:30 – Eve Hughes 11:15 – David Rychleski 6/29 – 8:00 – Kathy Michalina 9:30 – Tera Jean Notari 11:15 – David Rychleski <u>Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ</u> - celebrates the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist, that Jesus Christ is present in the Eucharist, not merely symbolically but in a true, real and substantial way.

The feast of Corpus Christi was proposed by Saint Thomas Acquinas in order to create a feast emphasizing the joy of the Eucharist being the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. The feast is liturgically celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday or it may be assigned to the Sunday after the Most Holy Trinity. At the end of Holy Mass, there is often a procession of the Blessed Sacrament displayed in a monstrance borne by the priest. The procession is followed by the Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

The custom developed of carrying the Blessed Sacrament in a splendid procession through the town after the Mass on Corpus Christi Day. During the procession stops are made at various points called "stations" and the Blessed Sacrament is put on an altar table while a Gospel passage is read and hymns are sung.

In the Polish town of Spycimierz (pictured below), parishioners arrange a carpet of live flowers about one kilometer long. A solemn procession will tread upon it as pictured below.
