In April, our parish received \$21,368.81 in total income and had \$43,175.21 in expenses. A portion of the gap reflects one-time repair costs and routine seasonal expenses and not ongoing monthly obligations. Our endowment and investment funds remain strong at over \$2.6 million, a testament to the faithful generosity of those who came before us. Every envelope, every offering, and every donation no matter the size helps keep our parish, our cemetery, our Youth Center, and our community strong. Thank you for your continued support.
